Here is a current estimate of sales:

Estimated member pre-sales thus far:	520 dozen
Estimated Rotary Club sales	45 "
Estimated Volvo sales	125 "

Total so far	685 dozen

We have a preliminary order for 1000 dozen. If pre-sales do not increase and we keep that same preliminary order, we would need to sell 315 dozen on the street!
